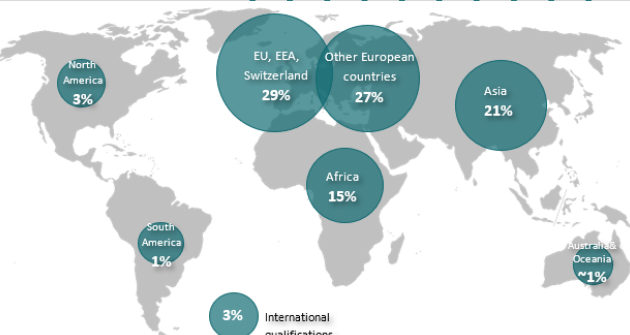

Events of the Year

- On 5 March 2023 Global Recognition Convention entered into force
- On 11-12 Sept 2023 a meeting of Baltic QA agencies organised
- On 3 Oct 2023 SKVC recognised by the World Federation for Medical Education as a QA agency which properly applies basic standards for medical education

QUALITY ASSURANCE

- 89 Decisions made on the evaluation and accreditation of individual HEIs' fields of study and levels of study
- 120 Experts from Lithuania, including academics, students, employers' representatives invited
- 1 Evaluation and accreditation of veterinary medical residency training carried out
- 9 Descriptors of the study fields are approved (6 new, 3 updated)
