

Rūta Mažeikienė

Assoc. prof. dr. Rūta Mažeikienė has a bachelor's degree in History and Theory of Arts (1997) and master's degree in Theatre Studies (2000). In 2005, she defended her doctoral dissertation in Humanities (History and Theory of Arts) at Vytautas Magnus university (VMU). Since 2000 she works at VMU Faculty of Arts: since 2006 she is a Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Arts, since 2009 she is an associate professor at the Department of Theatre studies. Rūta Mažeikienė did an internship at the Department of Dramaturgy of the Faculty of Arts, at Aarhus university (Denmark, 2004), gave visiting lectures (Erasmus Exchange program) at the universities of Bergen (Norway, 2009), Stockholm (Sweden, 2013) and Helsinki (Finland, 2015). She belongs to the board of the Association of Nordic Theatre Scholars (ANTS) and is a member of such international research associations as International Federation of Theatre Research (IFTR/FIRT) and European Association for the Study of Theatre and Performance (EASTAP). Since 2006 she has been a member of various national and international theatre jury, an expert of various organizations of art and science, including Lithuanian Council for Culture and Research Council of Lithuania. Since 2014 she has been participating as an expert in the external evaluation of study programs; in 2016 she joined the Study Evaluation Commission (Centre for Quality Assessment in High Education).
