Dr. Inga Stravinskienė has graduated from Vytautas Magnus University in 2005 completing her Master's degree in Education (specialisation - management of vocational training). In 2009, she graduated from Kaunas University of Technology with a Master's degree in Management and Business Administration (specialization - Personnel Management). In 2023, she received her PhD in social sciences from Vilnius University (specialization - management). From 2008 to the present she has been working at Kaunas College. During this period, she has held the position of a specialist in the Quality of Studies Service, and later as the head of this unit. Since 2018, she has been the Head of the Management and Quality Department of Kaunas College, lecturer. She is also supervising Kaunas College students' final theses. Since 2018, she has also been supervising, reviewing, and participating in the final thesis defence committee of the Master's theses of management students at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration of Vilnius University.
